On November 25, Gambia's landmark Truth, Reconciliation, and Reparations Commission (TRRC) delivered its final report, calling for the prosecution of those most responsible for human rights crimes during the rule of former president Yahya Jammeh. At the close of the TRRC hearings, incoming ICC prosecutor Karim Khan tweeted his agreement that "Justice must happen" for those crimes. This timely panel will examine why justice is important for The Gambia and how and where prosecutions could be carried out.
