AFLA Seminar to Coincide with Habre Judgement







From 30 May - 1 June, Africa Legal Aid (AFLA), in cooperation with FIBGAR and the Kenya Human Rights Commission, will convene a Seminar in Dakar, Senegal on 'Complementarity, the Habre Trial, and the Evolution of Universal Jurisdiction.' The meeting will coincide with the Habre judgement on 30 May. It is of historical importance to note that the trial in Senegal of the former Chadian leader by the Extraordinary African Chambers (EAC) is the first of its kind.

The meeting will address topical and emerging issues of international criminal justice, including Emerging Trends on Complementarity; Universal Jurisdiction; Victims Participation; Accountability for Sexual and Gender based Violence (SGBV); and the Role of the Defence.
