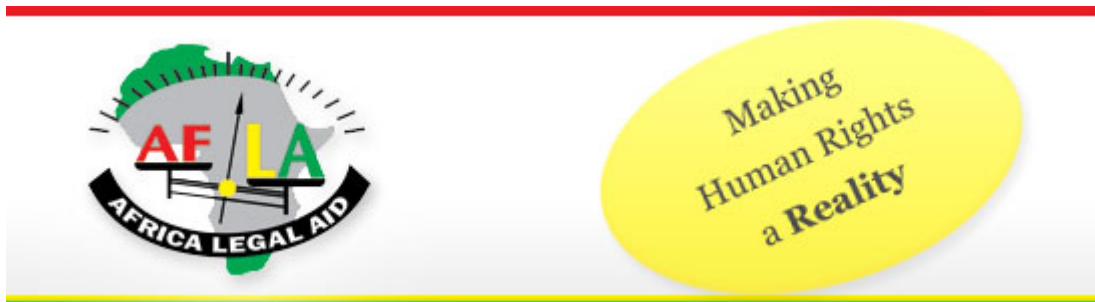

The Seminar was held at the African Union Headquarters in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, as a Side Event to the 29th Ordinary Session of the Assembly of Heads of State of the African Union, from 3 - 4 July 2017.

- *Emerging trends on Complementarity*
- *Incorporating Gender and Defence Perspectives*
